CLASSROOM USE—There is no charge to use the classroom for a small group activity or to baste your quilts. Please call ahead to check when the classroom is available.

Before attending any class at QE, you should be proficient in the basic operating of your sewing machine (i.e. winding the bobbin, threading etc.). If not, contact Jerry before your class for a FREE quick 15-minute tutorial on how to operate your machine.

29th and Sun. June 4th. Both are from 9:00am to 9:00pm and offer 12 hours of sewing. No phones (unless you bring one), no kids, and no cooking! Chef Steve will ensure there is plenty to eat—no cooking or cleaning up, just sewing. Check in anytime after 9am and checkout by 9pm. There is limited seating, so sign up quickly. The fee is \$75 and includes breakfast, lunch, snacks, and dinner, and all the laughs you can stand.

KIDS' CLASS & CAMP—Check out the offerings for the popular Kids' Class and the summer, week-long Kids' Camp. Both offer wonderful opportunities for children to take pride in a finished product while learning a new skill that challenges them to be creative.

SEWCIETY—Back by popular demand. On the fourth Friday of the month, get together with other quilters for an open sewing session. Bring one of your projects, along with food to share.

General Class Information:

Level 1 requires no previous knowledge of technique; **Level 2** requires rotary cutting skills; **Level 3** requires piecing experience. Kid's Class does not involve rotary cutting. Classes are filled on a "first come" basis. Class fees are due when registering. To receive store credit, you must cancel at least 48 hours before the class begins, otherwise, the fee is forfeited. Our teachers depend on class enrollment to prepare for class. Be sure to pick up and read the supply list if interested in a class. **Students receive a 10% discount on class supplies and fabric purchases.** Rental sewing machines are available for \$7/class. Please arrive 15 minutes early to set up and avoid class delays. Please do not bring children or guests to class with you. All classes are at least 2 hours and begin at 10:30am or 6:30pm, unless otherwise indicated. If you have an idea for a class, let Carol know. It only takes two to make a class, so find a friend to join you (and receive a discount for the class).

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

BALI BITS & BITES—Get together with Missy and a Bali pop or jelly roll to make three different bags. Class will meet two nights with a little bit of homework in between.

CONVEX ILLUSIONS—Carol will help you create this work of art, a "WOW" quilt that is easier than it looks.

GYPSY TOTE—This is the ideal tote because it holds a lot, it is easy to make, and it has no raw edges.

KIDS' CLASS—Miss Pat will be teaching kids how to make a pet placemat, a set of coasters, and a bedside caddy. Join her for one, two, or all three.

KIDS' SUMMER QUILT CAMP—Participate in a week-long class that includes snacks, fabric, and a neat quilt.

LITTLE LACIE BAGS—Missy will guide you through the steps in creating an adorable bag with one of the easiest zippers you'll ever install.

MACHINE PIECING—This is the class for a beginner quilter or one who needs to refresh her skills. You will end up with a beautiful sampler quilt.

MACHINE QUILTING—Joan can teach you how to free motion quilt using your own sewing machine. The technique is easier than most people think, and the class will give you the experience you need.

OVER AND DOWN UNDER—Have fun playing with color while creating a stunning quilt that is easy to piece (accurate quarter inch seams essential).

RETREAT—Each quarter we offer this fabulous opportunity to enjoy 12 hours of uninterrupted sewing

while Chef Steve takes care of all the cooking. Now we are offering it twice. Space is limited, so sign up quickly!

SIMPLE BEGINNINGS—This a beginner's class. Lois will teach you the basics—how to cut fabrics and how to sew an accurate seam allowance. You will end up with a 4, 8, 12, or 16-block log cabin quilt.

SIT UPON—Come create a place to "park your feet, your head, or your sitter." Missy will walk you through the steps to create a great little cushion/foot stool.

SLICE AND DICE—If you are a confident beginner, join Lois to make a quick, easy, and fun quilt that looks spectacular.

STACK & WHACK—This class is like the Energizer Bunny—it just keeps on going! Join Carol in making a really gorgeous, one-of-a-kind star or pinwheel quilt.

SUPER EASY BABY QUILT—Make a super easy animal baby quilt. The pattern is a giraffe, the sample uses an elephant, but Missy will help you use any animal you like.
